Forward Progress and More in 2019

ITWomen is a non-profit organization founded in 2002 by senior level women across technology industries. Through our partnerships with schools, non-profits, universities, corporate sponsors and professional organizations, we strive to narrow the gender gap in technology and increase the potential for innovation and economic growth through gender equity.

Our programs help ignite a passion for technology in the next generation by reaching out to girls in middle school, high school, and college through Role Model Speaker programs, Summer Camps and Scholarships. Equally importantly, our supportive network is there for our scholarship alumnae during their journey, as our members provide guidance, mentorship, and a path for their professional development. ITWomen is a multi-generational organization which began in the South Florida tri-county areas of Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach.

Our Impact

To date, ITWomen has provided over **\$704,000 in scholarships to 116 girls** pursuing degrees, leading to careers in IT and engineering.

Our Role Model outreach programs have touched **over 25,000 girls** in the South Florida area alone.

Building on Success

In 2019, we are proud to have continued producing so many of our initiatives in-house, including delivering more robotics and coding camps through internal resources, volunteers and ITWomen scholarship alumna than ever before. We continued the full management of the ITWomen scholarship application and award process, as well as management of the scholarship fund, maximizing monies available to award recipients and **awarded ten scholarships in 2019!** We remain confident that insourcing of these events has allowed us to have closer contact with and more impact on our program recipients.

Over \$80,000 was raised for college scholarships at ITWomen's 2018 Celebrity CIO Poker Tournament and Casino Night at the stylish DCOTA (Design Center of the Americas) in Dania Beach. Fantastic support from the tech community made 2018 another milestone year, allowing us to fund ten additional girls to pursue their dreams! Total ITWomen Scholarship funds raised to date have now surpassed \$704,000!

Moving Forward

The Current Landscape

As South Florida vies to compete in the innovation economy, it is vital our community works together to provide access to opportunities for youth to explore future focused careers that put them on the pathway to gain the skills that will not only fuel the innovation economy, but help to bridge the digital divide that grows amongst students of low socioeconomic status.

Despite census reports that job openings in technology and engineering fields continue to rise, the gap between men and women employed in them is widening.

According to NCWIT data, women hold more than half of all professional occupations yet fewer than 26% of them are computing-related occupations. We are focused on the fact, however, that women in engineering and technology earn 33% more than comparable women in non-STEM jobs.

Furthermore, studies by the American Association of University Women (AAUW) determined that the primary cause preventing women and girls from entering STEM careers was stereotypes and the need for a "human focus" (i.e. **role models** and

social programs) to support curriculum design.

Educators and industry leaders across South Florida agree that access to opportunity, and role models are critical to breaking down stereotypes, along with early intervention in order to recruit more girls into STEM programs.

Looking Ahead

It is evident to create the most innovative, life changing solutions, we need everyone's brain power and highlights the importance of ITWomen continuing our work across the STEM ecosystem to engage more girls., and support the advancement of Women already working inTech with additional programs.

Together, we can make our companies – and more importantly, society – better by giving young people, particularly girls, opportunities to succeed in STEM.
